#### Do you need to give a Cancellation Form?

You must give Pre-Contract information and a Cancellation Form if you enter into contract for goods or services (worth more than £42) in a customer's home. This gives them a **14 day cooling off period** to change their mind.

The cancellation notice should be given when the contract is formed i.e. when the customer agrees to you carrying out the work. Provided you give the correct



paperwork they may still be liable to pay for any services carried out up to the point where they cancel.

The consequences of **not** giving cancellation rights are **serious**. You may find yourself subject to investigation by Trading Standards as it is a criminal offence or you may struggle to enforce the contract, meaning that customers do not have to pay for work done.
